(b)	Senior Lecturer Grade II -	Rs.79,360 – 11 X 1,630 – 97,290 p.m. [U-AC 3 (II)] Academic Allowance of 189% of salary will be paid
(c)	Lecturer (Unconfirmed) -	$Rs.69,580 - 5 \times 1,630 - 77,730 p.m.$ [U-AC 3 (III) Academic Allowance of 164% of salary will be paid
